O R D E R

1. These petitions are filed under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of Divorce Petitions bearing Family Main Case No.97/2024 and Family Main Case No 96/2024 titled "*Rohit Kapoor vs. Ketaki Malhotra*", pending before the Court of Additional District Judge, Bhiwadi, District Alwar, Rajasthan to a Court of Competent Jurisdiction at Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, Haryana.

2. The grounds raised by the petitioner for seeking the transfer are that another case is pending at Gurugram; petitioner is staying at Noida and respondent-wife is staying at Gurugram.

3. On such consideration, we are of the view that the transfer can be allowed. Consequently, the Transfer Petitions are allowed.

4. Accordingly, Divorce Petitions bearing Family Main Case No.97/2024 and Family Main Case No 96/2024 titled "*Rohit Kapoor vs. Ketaki Malhotra*", pending before the Court of Additional District Judge, Bhiwadi, District Alwar, Rajasthan are transferred a Court of Competent Jurisdiction at Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, Haryana.

5. The transferor Court shall forward the records pertaining to the said cases to the transferee Court, as expeditiously as possible.

6. Parties are directed to appear before the concerned Court on 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2026.

7. The parties are permitted to attend the proceedings virtually, unless their presence is required by the trial Court.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
