Marriage between the respondent no.1 and petitioner is not disputed.

Various allegations and counter allegations have been made by both the parties against each other which can not be decide at this stage as they require evidence. However, considering the various allegations made by the petitioner, she prima facie appears to be an aggrieved person. Considering the purpose of grant of interim maintenance which is to avoid the vagrancy of wife pending litigation, the petitioner is held entitled to claim maintenance from the respondent no.1.

As regards the income of the parties it is submitted by petitioner that she is a graduate (B.A) and passed out in the year 2015 and got married in 2017. Now is stated to be pursuing her MA in Political Science. It is submitted that the petitioner has never worked and she is house wife and has no source of income to sustain herself.

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
