

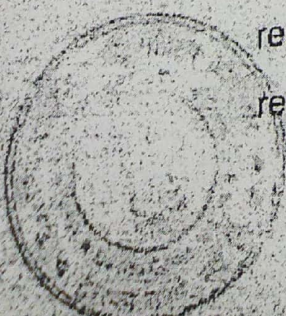
On the other hand it was submitted by respondent no.1 that prior to her marriage, petitioner was working with her mother in Beauty Parlor of her mother and still she is working with her mother in her Beauty Parlor, which is running from the residence of her mother.

As regards the income of the respondent no.1, it is the case of the petitioner that respondent is a graduate and is working in [redacted] Gurgaon and earning Rs.80,000/- per month. However, no document has been filed by the petitioner to substantiate her said claim. On the other hand the respondent has claimed that he is working as Customer Service Representative at [redacted] Pvt. Ltd., [redacted] and earning approximately Rs.29,000/- per month. The respondent has filed his statement of bank account and salary slips in support of his submissions.

Considering the submissions made and the documents filed on record, it appears that the income of the respondent no.1 is approximately Rs.29,000/- per month.

It is submitted by respondent no.1 that he has responsibility of his old parents. On the other hand, it is submitted on behalf of petitioner that the parents of respondent no.1 are getting senior citizen pension, as provided by the government to the Sr. Citizens. Same is disputed by the respondent no.1. No document is filed in support of their claim by either party.

Thus it is seen that both the petitioner as well as respondent are equally qualified being graduate in Arts. The respondent no.1 is earning Rs.29,000/- approximately but also has
