Complainant [redacted] residing at [redacted],
Cross, 8th Main, [redacted] 2nd [redacted] ie, [redacted] rd Stage,
[redacted] married accused [redacted], as decided by family elders, under
Hindu rituals in [redacted]. Due to accused [redacted] mother
Hande's ill health and to take care of her, the accused went to her mother's house on
[redacted], and until date she hasn't come back to our house. She, being at her mother's
house only, has conspired with many unknown people, to extort money from the
complainant and to dishonour the dignity and profession of the complainant.

Complainant's mother, Smt. [redacted], having undergone a brain stroke in
[redacted] and she being completely dependent on the complainant, and that complainant not being
able to leave his mother and reside somewhere else, the accused and her parents used to
apply pressure on the complainant to become resident son-in-law (ghar jamai). Later, on
[redacted] the accused filed divorce case ([redacted]) in 6th Additional Family Court,
praying to get Rs. 50,00,000/- as permanent alimony or monthly maintenance of Rs.
1,00,000/-. As per that when divorce notice was received by the complainant, he was
shocked. And later in order to have an out-of-court peaceful resolution, complainant
contacted a third party, [redacted] I. But the divorce dispute having magnified, the
complainant started to record the telephone calls with accused and her family members,
and the recorded calls were also shared with accused and her family members. When the
mediator and the accused's paternal uncle (chote papa) Late. [redacted] were
conversing over telephone, [redacted] only permitted to record the call. In the
said calls, the complainant has been provoked to come in as resident son-in-law (ghar jamai),

and the accused's side have attempted to extort money from the complainant. 21 months after filing divorce case, the accused has filed a maintenance case / [redacted], and in that she has made false allegations of dowry harassment, wrongful confinement, physical harassment, assault, threatening, taking away stridhan, not giving proper food and medicines to wife, provoking family members to torture wife, not allowing accused to meet her parents or relatives, conspiracy, throwing wife out of the house.

Accused had not mentioned any of the above mentioned allegations against complainant while filing divorce case in the Hon'ble Court. But 21 months later while filing maintenance case, she having made false allegations, this is done in order to threaten the complainant and to extort money from the complainant, is what the complainant has mentioned in his Hon'ble 32nd [redacted]
