10. Petitioner no.1 and respondent no.2 with the intervention of their well wishers and relatives entered into an amicable settlement vide Memorandum of Understanding dated ' ' ) and settled all their disputes amicably.

11. Complainant/respondent no.2 is present in person through video conferencing and has been identified by WSI ' ' of Police Station Hari Nagar and submits that matter has been settled and she does not wish to prosecute the matter any further.
